Health and Safety

Thank you so much for your support in helping to keep your children safe when entering and leaving school. We are going to have a new gate fitted at the bottom of the steps to make the yard more secure.

Children's safety is our top priority and adults need to supervise children as they leave school. If you need to speak to the teacher can you speak to the adult on the gate to leave a message or ring the office. If you can't leave a message and need to speak to the teacher we will ask them to ring you back.

<u>Jewellery</u> - Please remember if children wear earrings they should be small studs which can be removed by the child or covered with plasters for PE

Reminders:

- Just a reminder for nursery, reception and KS1, if you haven't completed your collection sheet can we have it back in school as soon as possible. If we do not have other names on the collection sheet we will assume that only the main carer will be collecting them.
- Safety in school- if someone else is collecting your child could you please let the office know before 2:45. Thank you.
- Remember we do have a breakfast club which starts at 8am and is £1.00 per day if you would like your child to attend Reception to Year 6 just give us a call and we will add their name to the list.

School Day

The school day at the moment is 9.00 until 3pm. It is really important that your child is in on time or they will miss valuable learning.

We do have flexibility at the beginning and end of the day 8.50-9 and 3.00 until 3.10.

Teachers are working with children from 8.50 and until 3.10.

Schools are required, from September 2023, to provide a longer school day (32.5 hours) and the flexibility in teaching time is preparing children and staff for this change.
