Teachers Strike action

Industrial action for teachers is due to take place on Tuesday 28th February. School will be closed to the following year groups: Nursery Reception Year 1 Year 4 Year 5 The following classes will be open: 2-year olds, Year 2, Year 3, Year 6

Morning arrangements

Following concerns over congestion on a morning at the school gate we have looked at an alternative way for children to come into school.

Starting on Monday 27th February we will be opening the gate at 8.45 for children to access the yard. They will be supervised by staff from that time on the yard. At 8.50 staff will come out to collect children, they will line up with their own class and be taken into school. Mrs Elmes, Rachael and Paula will still be available to take any messages and will be there until 9 to ensure all children are in school and then the main gate will be locked.

Arrangements for nursery and 2 year olds remain the same.

The arrangements for collection will remain the same where we have a staggered collection between 3pm and 3.10pm.

If you need to speak to your child's teacher we are always willing to have a conversation however we would ask that you wait until all children have gone or ask someone on the gate to pass on a message and the teacher will give you a ring.
