How the funding has been allocated:

	Cost	Impact
Transport to cluster organised sports festivals eg Tag Rugby, High 5 Netball, cross country etc	£60 per event x 6 <b>£360</b>	Chn have the opportunity to participate in competitive sport and represent their school at sporting events throughout the academic year.
After School Club Sports Coach - £40/week Chn contribute and rest subsidised by school	£20 per week x 35 (subsidised) <b>£800</b>	Chn of all year groups have access to a sports club after school. Chn will benefit from specialised coaching in football.
Multiskills Coaching throughout the year for all KS2 chn	£200 per half term <b>£1200</b>	All chn have access to multiskills provided by an experienced coach. Chn have opportunity to develop team work, technical skills and game skills.
Swimming - KS2 (pool hire, coaching and transport costs)	<b>£750</b>	In order to fulfil the NC requirements all chn in KS 2 are able to attend swimming lessons throughout the year.
Swimming booster sessions	£42.50/pupil x 15chn = <b>£637.50</b>	Additional swimming lessons for chn in Year 5/6 who have previously only achieved NC below level 3.
Athlete in school for the day Dan Gardiner - Decathlete	<b>£368</b>	All chn in school had opportunity to work with the athlete throughout a day. Chn were inspired and motivated in sporting activities, realising importance of goals and determination to succeed in all aspects of curriculum as well as PE.
GPS Units x10 and staff training	£1269 £730 <b>£1999</b>	Resource is to help make all areas of the curriculum active, allowing cross curricular links to be made between physical activities and other areas of

		the curriculum. Also to enhance teaching and learning in the outdoor environment.
NPQML leadership in sports -H. Airey Supply cover	<b>£446.25</b> £150/day <b>£750</b>	Leadership training course to enable a member of staff to lead the PE curriculum effectively.
After school sports club Teacher salary 1 hour per week	£35/per week x 35 <b>£1225</b>	Chn of all year groups have access to a sports club after school. Chn have opportunity to access a variety of sports and games activities provided by teaching staff.
CPD courses for staff	<b>£200</b>	Ensure that all staff remain skilled and up to date with current requirements in PE curriculum.
Resources and equipment	<b>£264.25</b>	Resources are audited, evaluated and bought as required to ensure all elements of PE curriculum can be taught effectively in school with appropriate equipment.
