

St Helen Auckland Community Primary School Behaviour Policy Addendum



Covid 19 September 2020

The safety and well-being of our school community is our number one priority. All children should continue to adhere to the principles outlined in the Behaviour Policy. They need to pay particular attention to:

- 1 - Being careful and considerate, respectful and obedient to adults in school. Listen carefully and respond respectfully.
- 2 - Being polite and friendly to all in the school community and remember to use manners. Kind words and kind actions.
- 3 - Behaving in safe and responsible ways.

These are all in line with our school rules of caring for our school, caring for each other and always doing our best.

Children in school should:

Respect the revised school expectations within the bubbles and wider school situations

- Adhere to the revised rules and expectation for entering and exiting the school site
- Enter and exit one at a time
- Stay in your own bubble areas / room throughout the school day
- Use only your designated entry and exit points for play times
- Stay at your tables unless directed otherwise
- Keep to social distancing rules in class, in the hall and in the playground
- Only use the resources directed to do so

Know and follow expected Self Care and Health needs

- Wash hands when directed to throughout the school day
- Tell an adult if you feel unwell with any Covid symptoms (adults to share these with children)
- Know and follow the catch it, bin it, kill it protocols for sneezing and coughing
- Remember to not touch your face in school
- Dispose of tissues in lidded bins or using class toilets
- Use the correct bubble toilets with respect and maintaining social distancing
- Use your own resource packs – no sharing
- Bring own clean water bottles full of water – no sharing of food or drinks
- Bring only agreed items into school (lunch box, water bottle, coat)

Rewards for positive behaviours

Smiles
Praise
Stay on the sunshine
Email / text messages home

Sanctions for negative behaviours

Reminders
Staff move child to the cloud
More reminders
Staff move child to rain cloud
Dangerous / adverse behaviours causing a risk to others – SLT sent for
Parents informed – text / email
Parents requested to escort child from the premises
Meeting with Parents – risk assessment completed / targets set

Some behaviours that may not have caused as much concern previously may now be seen as adverse behaviours as they may cause risk to others. This may now have to result in SLT intervention and even parents / carers escorting child from the premises. Consideration at this point may need to be given to an exclusion from school.

Concerning behaviours:

- Spitting
- Deliberate coughing onto others
- Physical attacks
- Deliberate flouting of social distancing requirements in school or arriving and leaving school

Staff in school should:

- Follow health and safety and hygiene procedures.
- Inform Headteacher by telephone if displaying any Covid 19 symptoms whilst at home
- Inform Headteacher immediately if displaying any Covid 19 symptoms whilst in school
- Follow the procedure for testing and inform Headteacher of the outcome immediately with a copy of the outcome
- Follow any new procedures on social distancing
- Wear PPE if managing intimate care / first aid
- Do not mix with other bubbles within school
- Wear clean clothes each day
- Discuss any concerns immediately with SLT

Parent / carers should:

- Not enter to the school building without prior appointment

- When dropping off children leave the school aged children at the school gate. Nursery parents to leave child at the Nursery gate
- When collecting children follow instructions and do not congregate on the site or at entry and exit points outside of school
- Keep any younger children close by (in a buggy, holding hands or on reigns)
- **Arrive on time for pick up and drop off. If you miss this time you MUST phone school to arrange an alternate time slot**
- Inform school if child is going to be absent by 9.00am each morning and be prepared to discuss the symptoms
- If requested to collect your child you need to do so immediately (Covid 19 symptoms or dangerous behaviours)
- Keep contact details up to date

Visitors should:

- Be by arrangement only
- Sign in at the main office and leave a contact number
- Be escorted around school at all times
- Meetings to follow the guidance set up in the Headteachers room or the Qube on the school field.
