Personal, Social and Emotional

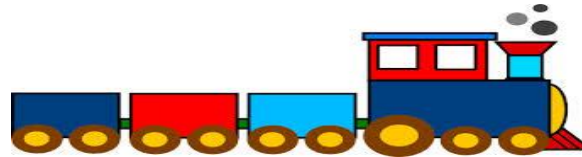
- Likes/dislikes in relation to different ways of traveling
